Who's Your One? When you think of someone *far from* God, who's the first person who comes to mind? When you think of someone who has *disconnected* from God, who's the first person who comes to mind? Is it a neighbor? Coworker? Parent? No matter who it is, God can use you to reach them! This month we're committing to reaching ONE for Jesus Christ. Last Sunday, many of our members wrote the name of their ONE on the tower in the sanctuary. If you haven't yet written your ONE on the tower, you may do so during any worship service. As you pass by that tower each Sunday, pray for the people listed. If you want to come to the church during office hours and have a special time of prayer, we'd love to let you in the sanctuary to pray.



The next three Sundays would be great opportunities to invite your ONE to worship with you. I will be speaking on three important topics, and every Sunday will have a clear evangelistic appeal:

September 15 - The message will be entitled "Jesus' Warning", and I'll show how Hell is real, but no one has to go there!

September 22 - The message will be entitled "Jesus' Hope", and we'll consider how awesome Heaven will be.

September 29 - Baptism Day! I'll preach on "Jesus' Desire." I'll be calling for those yet to believe to believe and be baptized; for those who believe but have not been baptized to be baptized; and for those already baptized to remain faithful to the Lord Jesus. We will be ready to baptize people that day who respond (we have shirts, shorts, and robes ready!).

Remember, our goal for this year is 60 baptisms - a 200% increase over last year. For that to happen, we need everyone to pray, share, and invite!
