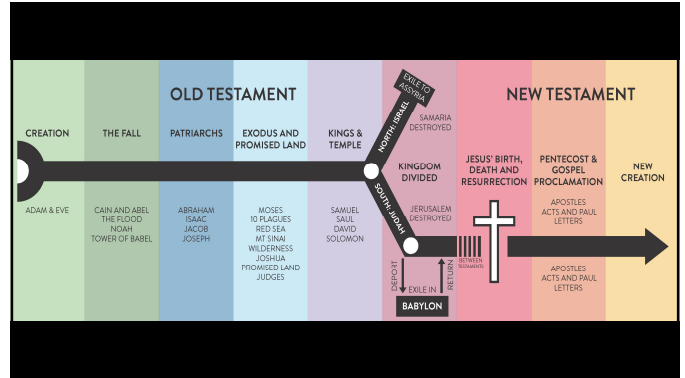
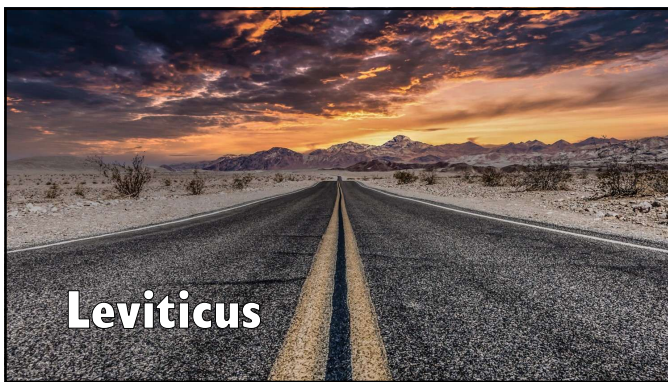




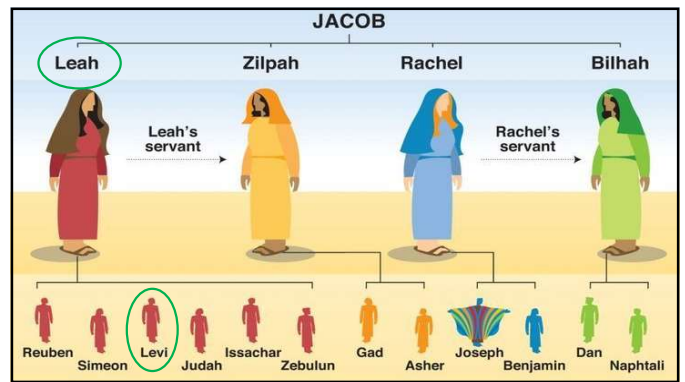

- ▶ Firstfruits (1 Day) – Nisan 16
- ▶ Weeks (1 Day) – 50 days after Firstfruits. (Pentecost)

## The Three Fall Feasts

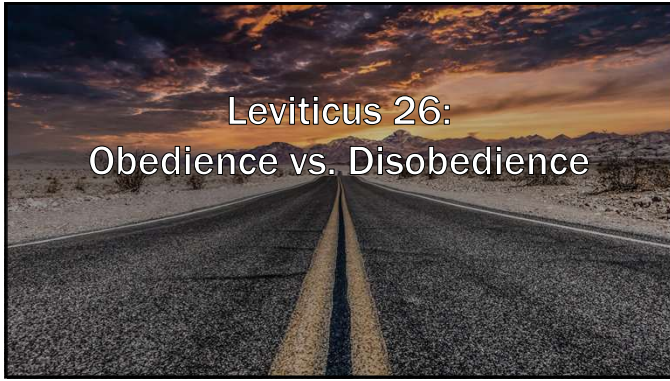
- ▶ Trumpets – 1 Day (Rosh Hashanah)
  - ▶ Start of the civil year
- ▶ Day of Atonement – 1 Day (Yom Kippur)
  - ▶ Ten days after the feast of trumpets

- ▶ Hanukkah (December 164 B.C.)

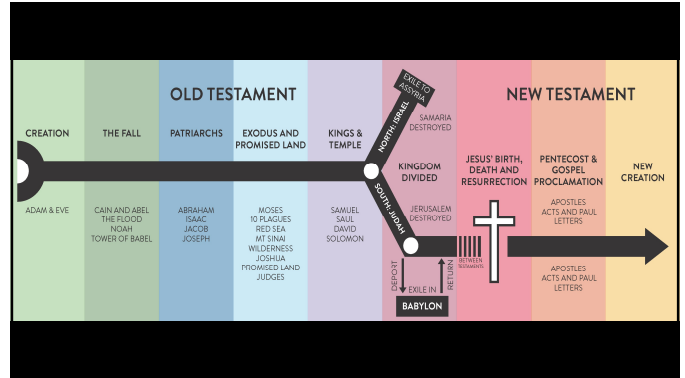

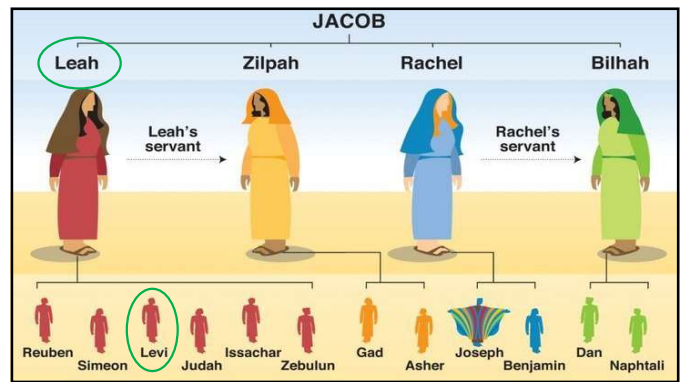

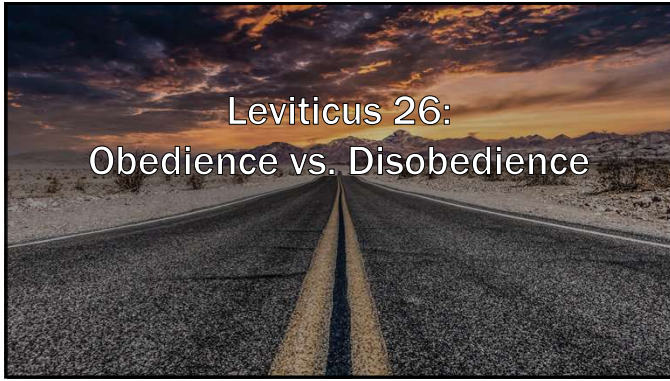
